Education-Related Bills Passed into Law

- Chapter 33 (HF 1143) appropriates \$100M into the school unemployment insurance aid account, extends by one year the expiration date for the school unemployment aid account in the special revenue fund, and cancels a 2023 appropriation of \$77.232M for the Minneapolis-Duluth Northern Lights Express rail project.
- Chapter 25 (HF 1090) renames the Library Construction Grants in Minnesota Statutes 134.45 to “The Mary C. Murphy Library Construction Grants Program” to honor the late former Representative Mary Murphy.

Policy Proposals Still Under Negotiation (House Highlights)

- Minnesota Department of Education (MDE) Office of Inspector General (OIG) statute updates and data protection clarifications;
- Education innovation statutory reorganization;
- Extend the emergency short-call substitute pilot program;
- Permit schools to start their school year after September 1 but before Labor Day for the 2026-2027 and 2027-2028 school years only;
- Updates statutory references to epinephrine delivery systems;
- Codify IDEA state complaint process into state statute;
- Kindergarten entry assessment one-year implementation delay

Policy Proposals Still Under Negotiation (Senate Highlights)

- The READ Act;
- Charter school accountability and oversight;
- Attendance reporting
- School Cell Phone Ban starting in 2026-27 school year
- Health subject-matter directions to statewide standards process;
- Allowing certain students to carry, and administer if necessary, opiate antagonists;
- Amend the exemption process for the prohibition on Native American mascots in public schools;
- Extend the emergency short-call substitute pilot program
